the previous date of hearing.

2. The hearing scheduled through Video Conferencing at D.C. Office, Ludhiana on 14.10.2020 could not be held due to break in connectivity due to technical glitch at Punjab State Information Commission.

3. Shri Darshan Singh, the relative of Shri Baldev Singh, appellant comes in person before the Bench at Chandigarh. He states that out of over time claimed by the appellant for 41 months, only overtime of 11 months has been paid and the balance amount is yet to be paid to the appellant.

3. Shri Jatinderpal Sijngh, G.M. P.R.T.C. Patiala Depot/PIO comes present to attend the hearing along with Mrs. Rajesh Sharma, Superintendent. The PIO produces before the Bench letter dated 09.10.2020, copy of which has been received by post in the Commission. He states that the Forms of overtime filled in by he appellant from February, 2005 to May, 2008 were entered in the office register and the payment of Rs.58,425/- has been made to the appellant vide cheque No.890792 dated 21.12.2011.

4. On the asking of the Bench, the PIO clarifies that the bills for any claim are to be submitted to the office within a period of one year. But in the instant case, the appellant who had retired in the year 2011,

has not adhered to the schedule laid down as per Rules and has submitted balance of the bills for over time claim much after his retirement. The appellant had also filed an Application before the Court of Ms. Jatinder Kaur, Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Patiala under Industrial Disputes Act, 1948 claiming dues of Rs.5,04,000/- along with interest @ 18%. The Ld. Court observed that apart from the payment of dues of over time of Rs.58,425/-, nothing remains due to the appellant towards the respondents and the Application was dismissed vide order dated 26.04.2019. The PIO also states before the Bench that the appellant has also submitted new forms for claiming over time by post which have been receipted in the office on 26.08.2020, on which no action can be taken by the office as per the order of Ld. Court dated 26.04.2019. He further states that no further appeal has been filed by the appellant against the order dated 26.04.2019.

5. The Bench peruses the letter dated 09.10.2020 as also the order of Court enclosed therewith. The representative of appellant is apprised of the Rule position as made clear by the PIO. On the asking of the Bench, the representative of the appellant states that the letter dated 09.10.2020 has not been received by the appellant. Accordingly, the Bench directs the PIO to hand over a copy of the letter dated 09.10.2020 along with the copy of Court dated 26.04.2019. The PIO hands over the same to the representative of the appellant during the hearing.

6. The Bench, on perusal of the documents produced by the PIO before the Bench and considering the submissions made by the PIO, is convinced that the appellant has been supplied information by the PIO as available in their official records.

7. In view of the above, no further intervention of the Bench is called for. **The appeal case is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
