It is already placed in the case-file.

After hearing the parties concerned, it emerges that the required information has not been supplied to the information seeker till date.

Hence, the respondent PIO concerned is directed to comply with the orders dated 30.10.2018 passed by the Commission by paying compensation of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) to the applicant before or on the next date of hearing.
