This order may be read with reference to the order dated 17.11.2021 passed by this Bench on 1. the previous hearing.

2. The case has been heard today in Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Manmohan Upneja, Advocate comes present in person to attend the hearing before the Bench on behalf of Vivek Anand Ahuja, appellant. He states that with regard to reply received from the PIO, the appellant has submitted objections vide letter dated 08.11.2021 and that the appellant has also filed objections before the Commission on 06.12.2021.

3. Neither the PIO has come present nor he has deputed any of his representatives to attend the hearing on behalf of the PIO. However, on perusal of the case file, the Bench observes that a letter dated 04.02.2022 has been received from the PIO stating that in pursuance of the directions of Bench, no deficiencies have been pointed out by the appellant. It has been further stated that the PIO, on account of having been deputed on election duty, is unable to attend the hearing and has also requested to advise the appellant to apprise him of the deficiencies so that the same could be removed and rectified information could be supplied to the appellant.

4. The Bench observes that this is the second hearing in the present appeal case. The PIO was absent during the previous hearing and is absent for today's hearing also, whereas he could have deputed any of his representatives to attend the hearing. This attitude of the PIO is viewed adversely. The PIO-cum-Sub Registrar, Fazilka is issued show cause notice to explain his absence and as to why action should

not be taken against him and also as to why penalty should not be imposed in the instant case for failing to appear for the hearing. He is also directed to file a written reply to the show cause notice as to why the appellant should not be compensated for the mental harassment suffered by him in getting the information.

5. In addition to the written reply, the PIO is hereby given an opportunity u/s 20(1) proviso thereto for personal hearing before the imposition of such a penalty, on the next date of hearing. He may take note that in case they does not file the written reply and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date fixed, it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceedings against him ex-parte.

6. The Bench, from the perusal of the aforesaid letter of PIO, observes that deficiencies have not been received by the PIO. He is directed to call the appellant to office on any working day to allow him access to the official records. After the records are inspected by the appellant, the PIO will supply him the information as may be identified by the appellant, duly attested by the PIO, before the next hearing.

7. After supplying the information, the PIO is directed to file an affidavit on non judicial stamp paper duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information as available in the official records in AC No.3608 of 2021 has been supplied to the appellant. It be further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the statement made is true and correct. Original affidavit be sent to the appellant and photocopy of the same be sent to the Commission for record.

With the aforesaid directions, the matter is adjourned. To come up for hearing on
 16.05.2022 at 11.30 AM before the Bench in Commission's office at Chandigarh. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.

<u>ORDER</u>

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 17.11.2021 passed by this Bench on

the previous hearing.

2. The case has been heard today in Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Gurmeet Singh, complainant comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench.

3. Smt. Manpreet Kaur, Principal, GSSS (Boys), Bhinder Kalan, District Moga comes present to attend the hearing in person. She states that the information was supplied to the complainant, but the same was received back undelivered and now she has brought along the said information for handing over to the complainant. She also states that letter dated 05.02.2022 was sent to the Hon'ble Commission. She also produces original affidavit before the Bench.

4. On the asking of the Bench, the PIO shows the information as well as the original affidavit to the complainant who, on perusal of the same, states that he is not satisfied with the same as the receipt shown to him relates to the work of levelling done through trolleys whereas he has asked for the receipt for money paid for the work done by hiring the JCB Machine containing signatures of JCB owner. He also contends that the information should have been delivered at his residence as he has deposited the requisite fee for the same.

5. The Bench observes that the contents of affidavit are not in consonance with the directions of the Bench given vide order dated 17.11.2021 and moreover, it is not on non-judicial stamp paper and as such, it is not accepted. The PIO is directed to again call the complainant for inspection of records. The complainant is also made clear that the information as available with the PIO in the official records can only be made available.

6. Post deliberations, the PIO is again directed to file an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information as available in official records in CC No.1034/2021 has been supplied to the complainant and the letter number and date be also mentioned therein. It be also incorporated therein that the complainant was called to office for inspection of records in writing as also the position whether the complainant inspected the records or declined to inspect the same. It be further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the statement made is true and correct. The PIO is directed to bring along the original affidavit and copy of the information supplied as also the relevant official records and to produce the same before the Bench on the next hearing.

7. With the aforesaid directions, the matter is adjourned. To come up for hearing on
16.05.2022 at 11.30 AM before the Bench in Commission's office at Chandigarh. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.

<u>ORDER</u>

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 17.11.2021 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.

7. The Bench also directs the PIO-cum-VDO, Gram Panchayat, Ranike, Block Attari, District Amritsar to file an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information as available in the official records in AC No.3628/2021 & AC No.3629/2021 has been supplied to the appellant. It be further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the statement made is true and correct. Original affidavit be sent to the appellant and photocopy of the same be sent to the Commission for record.
