





ORDER

- 1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 08.02.2021 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing as the hearing of 28.04.2021 was postponed.
- 2. The case has been heard today through Cisco Webex. Shri Tejinder Singh, representative of the appellant attends the hearing through Cisco Webex on his behalf. He states that the appellant has not received any information till date.
- 3. Neither the PIO attends the hearing through Cisco webex nor has deputed any other official to attend the hearing on his behalf nor any information has been supplied to the appellant. The PIO was also absent during the last hearing. This indifferent attitude of the PIO is viewed adversely.
- 4. The PIO O/o Secretary, Regional Transport Authority is issued a show cause notice to explain his absence and as to why action should not be taken against him in the instant case. He is also directed to file a written reply to the show cause notice as to why the appellant should not be compensated for the mental harassment suffered by him in getting the information.
- 5. In addition to the written reply, PIO is hereby given an opportunity u/s 20(1) proviso thereto for a personal hearing before the imposition of such a penalty, on the next date of hearing. He may take note that in case he does not file the written reply and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing



on the next date fixed, it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceeding against him ex-parte.
