I have gone through the RTI application dated 22.12.2020 and discussed about the sought for information with both the parties. The SPIO is directed to send the attested copies of bills of amount used to the complainant/applicant through registered post within days and compliance report be sent back to the Commission.

This is a complaint case and the matter of the complainant/applicant has been resolved by the SPIO, so the present complaint case is **disposed of and closed**.
