Present : The Appellant, Sh. Rakesh Kumar Gupta present.
Sh. Ashish Kumar, PIO, LG – III Branch along with Sh. Raminder, APIO –cum- Senior Assistant is present from the Department.

ORDER:

This case was last heard on 13.10.2021 vide which the Respondent / PIO was directed to send information / reply to first ten complaints only (filed through RTI request) to him by registered post or through email.

In today's hearing, both the parties are present in the Commission.

The Appellant, Sh. Rakesh Kumar states that incomplete information has been supplied to him. He further mentions about his email dated 11.12.2021 which has been sent to the Commission and is taken on record.

On the other hand, the PIO, Sh. Ashish Kumar shows the information to the Commission during the proceedings of the Court and further explains about the first nine complaints, that what has happened and which have been forwarded to the concerned department along with that he also explains that one complaint i.e. on serial number 10 of dated 07.01.2021 is with them and **the status of the same will be conveyed to the Appellant by next week.**

After going through the supplied information i.e. letter dated 07.12.2021 it has been observed that the information relating to first 9 complaints of the Appellant has been answered by the department and one complaint dated 07.01.2021 is within the office of Sh. Ashish Kumar and he is directed to make sure that the status of the Complainant should be conveyed to the Appellant by the next week.

On asking about the dates from Sh. Ashish Kumar, PIO that on which dates the concerned nine complaints have been forwarded to the concerned department to which Sh. Raminder, Senior Assistant shows the print out copy of their official gmail id in which the forwarded nine complaints have been highlighted along with dates, the same has been given to the Appellant as well as to the Commission during the proceedings of the Court.

In view of above, this case be disposed of and closed with the consent of both the parties but the PIO, Sh. Ashish Kumar is directed to submit the status of the Complaint dated 07.01.2021 to the Appellant by the next week along with a copy to the Commission, failing which an action would be taken against the PIO concerned.
