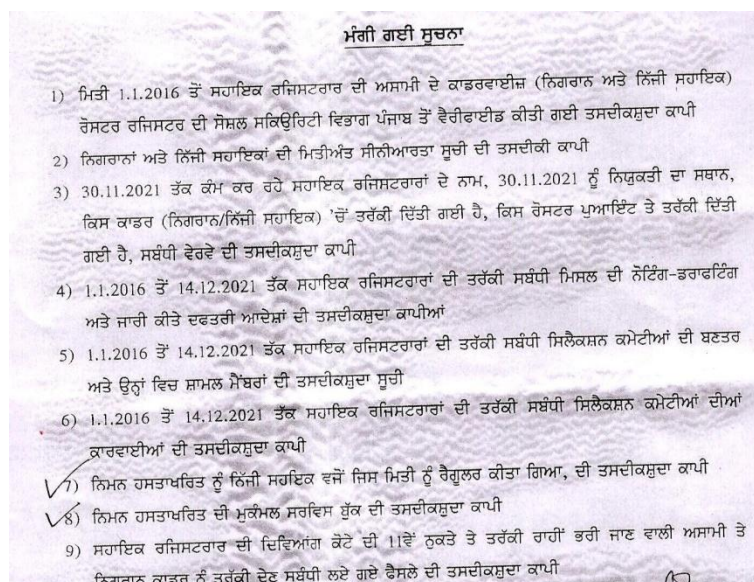

Certified copies of all letters/directions from Govt or from the Punjab Transparency and Accountability in Delivery of Public Services Commission to DC/Tehsildar/DRO to send periodic statements of pendency of all RTS Services relating to Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar Ludhiana West and copies of all periodic statements sent to Commission by Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar Ludhiana West , and copies of all RTS -1 Forms maintained by Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar Ludhiana West till date.
6. Details of all services that are being provided electronically and those that are in process of being provided electronically in which Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar Ludhiana West is the designated Officer
7. Copy of orders by Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar Ludhiana West vide which the services and all time periods/details are displayed on Notice Boards for public
