ORDER

The brief facts of the case can be summarized as under:

The appellant had sought information about the action having been taken across the board in the State on a complaint made by him to the Chief Minister, Punjab. It is directed against the hotels, restaurants, food courts and the eateries for violating food safety norms. The office of the Chief Minister had forwarded his complaint to the Principal Secretary to Government of Punjab in the Department of Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Chandigarh, who in turn have endorsed it to the Civil Surgeons and District Health Authorities for appropriate action. Having failed to find a satisfactory response from the field formations the appellant had filed second appeal with the Commission.

From various communications filed before the Commission it transpires that the respondents have taken due measures to enforce the requirements of Food Safety Act in the field by

way of issuing public notices and making regular inspections. Legions of documents are generated on the score. The appellant should have been specific. The information sought is general in nature and is impractical to be provided. The Commission feels that his complaint has been suitably addressed and he has been sufficiently informed.
