<u>ORDER</u>

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 15.09.2020 vide which the abovementioned appeal case was adjourned to be heard on 02.12.2020. However, on 02.12.2020 the case could not be heard and hence was postponed to be heard on 16.02.2021, i.e today.

2. The Appellant states that, as directed in the previous hearing, he had gone to inspect the record in the office of the Respondent, but he was not allowed to inspect the same. He has also filed his reply in this regard, which is taken on record.

3. The Respondent states that the information has already been provided to the Appellant.

4. After hearing both the parties and perusing the case file, it is ascertained that the Appellant was not allowed to inspect the record in the office of the Respondent. This clearly shows that the Respondent has failed to comply with the orders of the Commission. Hence, *PIO O/o Principal, Medical College, Patiala* is directed to show cause in writing or through affidavit under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act, as to why penalty be not imposed

upon him for willful delay/ denial of the information to the RTI applicant and why the compensation be not awarded to the complainant under Section 19 (8)(b) of the Act for detriment suffered.

In addition to his submission, the PIO is also hereby given an opportunity under Section 20(1) proviso, thereto, for a personal hearing before the imposition of such penalty on the next date of hearing. He may note that in case he does not file his submission and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date fixed, it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceedings against him ex-parte. *Further, the Respondent –PIO is also directed to Call the Appellant to their office on any working day for inspection of record within three days.*
