1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 29.12.2020 passed by the Bench on the previous hearing.
2. The case has been heard through V.C. in office of D.C., Ludhiana. Shri Bharat Bhushan Mattu, appellant has not come present to attend the hearing through V.C.
3. Shri Amardeep Singh, Clerk, O/o Secretary, R.T.A. Ludhiana comes present to attend the hearing through V.C. On the asking of the Bench, he states that the appellant visited their office for inspection of records on 03.02.2021. The appellant demanded copies of property returns of Class-A Officers, he was informed that no such information is available with their office. Further regarding inspection of attendance register of office and station leaving permissions, he was clarified that as per Hon'ble

Supreme Court orders, this cannot be made available to him. The balance information has already been supplied to him vide letter dated 28.08.2020. An affidavit dated 24.08.2020 has also been sent to the appellant as per directions of Bench,.

4. Since the appellant is absent, he is contacted on mobile phone. On the asking of Bench, he informs that he is out of station. He is apprised of the version of representative of the PIO. He states that he was not shown any records as stated by the representative of the PIO. The appellant states that he is not satisfied with the information supplied and also questions the contents of affidavit and states that he wants an affidavit which has point-wise details of his RTI application.

5. The Bench observes that it is unfortunate on the part of appellant not to attend the hearing despite being aware of the date of hearing. The Bench examines the case file in detail. The Bench is convinced that adequate information stands supplied and also accepts the affidavit filed by the respondent wherein on oath, it has been clearly stated that information, as available in official records stands, supplied and nothing beyond that is available.

6. In view of the above, the Bench feels that no further intervention of the Bench is required. **The appeal case is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
