
The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Jalandhar. As per the respondent, the information has been provided to the complainant.

As per the amount raised the appellant should have got close to 1000 pages (postage fee deducted). Since the PIO has not provided the number of pages as per the fee raised, the PIO is directed to refund the excess amount immediately after deducting the postage charges for sending the information.
