## ORDER

The respondent-Public Information Officer further states that he has joined as Block Development and Panchayats Officer Khadoor Sahib on 19.6.2020 and due to unavoidable circumstances the information has delayed but at the time of the RTI application i.e. 8.1.2019 other incumbent was posted as Block Development and Panchayats Officer, Khadoor Sahib. He further requested to withdraw the show cause notice issued to him for imposition of penalty.

4. After hearing the oral/written submissions the Commission satisfied with the reply of the respondent-Public Information Officer Sh. Gurmeet Singh, therefore, the show cause notice issued to him for imposition of penalty is hereby withdrawn. As far as the information is concerned, the same has already been provided to the appellant. Accordingly, the Commission observes that no further action is required in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed.
