However, in case the appellant chooses to seek information under the departmental procedure then the checklist of that department has to be complied with by the appellant. Since, the appellant chooses the information under RTI Act, the respondent-Public Information Officer has to supply the Information as has been sought by the appellant.

4. After going through the submissions of the parties, judicial pronouncements and record available in the case file, the respondent-Public Information Officer is directed to
