Hence, I award a compensation of Rs. 2,000/- (Two Thousand Only) to the appellant. The compensation amount must be paid by the respondent PIO concerned through cheque or demand draft in favor of **Renu Sharma** from the account of Public Authority and not from the individual's account.

Respondent PIO is directed to produce a copy of the cheque or demand draft on the next date of hearing.

6. In view of the defying attitude of the respondent PIO neither attending the court nor submitting any explanation for the delay in supplying the information within the time schedule as prescribed under the RTI Act 2005, the court comes to a logical conclusion that it is a fit case for the imposition of penalty amounting to Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) on the PIO. Therefore, taking a lenient view, I impose a penalty of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand Only) on the concerned respondent PIO, Sh. Naresh Kumar, Office of BDPO, Talwara. The Drawing and Disbursing Officer of the office of the Additional Deputy Commissioner (General), Hoshiarpur is directed to deduct the amount of penalty of Rs. 10,000/- from the salary of the concerned respondent PIO and deposited in the State Treasury in the following Head of Account and to report its compliance to the Commission:-
