The RTI request is dated 04.12.2020. The complaint has been received in the Commission on 15.09.2021.

On the last date of hearing, held on 08.11.2021 ;

- i) The respondent PIO through a reply vide letter no. 1320 dated 03.11.2021 signed by Additional Deputy Director, Panchayats, had intimated the Commission that the requisite information i. e. Pension-Book was not sent to the complainant.
- ii) The complainant was not present and an opportunity was given to the appellant to confirm whether he received the information (which has been sent by respondent PIO vide letter dated 03.11.2021) or not.

- ii) The respondent PIO concerned was directed to supply the certified copies of the required information to the appellant during his visit to office.

The RTI request is dated 28.02.2020. First appeal is dated 01.06.2020. Second appeal has been received in the Commission on 03.09.2020.

On the last date of hearing, held on 08.11.2021 ;

- i) Sh. Balvir Singh, Superintendent, stated that whatever information is available in the official record, was supplied to the appellant and for remaining information, a reply was sent to the appellant vide letter no. 150 dated 20.05.2021 and again sent vide letter dated 01.09.2021.

After examining the documents placed on record, it is found that the respondent PIO through a reply vide letter no. 150 dated 20.05.2021 and again vide letter dated 01.09.2021 has supplied the requisite information to the appellant. The said replies are placed in the case-file.

The appellant, Sh. Nitin Kumar Garg is absent from today's hearing without any intimation to the Commission. He has neither pointed out any deficiency in the information supplied to him, to the respondent-PIO, nor approached the Commission with any contrary claim in that regard.

On the last date of hearing, held on 15.11.2021 ;

- i) The respondent PIO through a reply vide letter no. 4400-4401 dated 21.09.2021, had intimated the Commission that a reply was sent to the appellant.
- ii) The appellant through a letter dated 14.11.2021 had intimated the Commission that the required information was not given to him by the respondent PIO.
