ORDER

- This order may read with reference to previous order dated 15.02.2021 vide which the respondent authority was directed to provide a clear and specific information to the Appellant. The appellant had filed RTI application 22.10.2020 seeking information pertaining to availability of infrastructure and other related information to it. Accordingly, the case is fixed for today.
- 2. Today's (Second) Hearing: Both parties are present. The respondent made a written submission in the Commission dated 25.02.2021 vide diary no.4381. The appellant on the other hand submitted a rejoinder to the stand taken by the respondents. A copy was also handed to respondents.
- <u>3.</u> As regards the question as to whether the denial of information could be held to be justified, it would be important to refer to the grounds taken by the respondent authority in this case, which may be summarised as under:
 - that due to Covid 19 pandemic the delay has been occurred.
 (supported his stand with annexure of press cuttings reporting on Thapar University turns into Covid hotspot, 38 infected in three days)
 - 4. As regards, the ground taken by the respondent authority, the Commission expressed its displeasure on the casual and callous approach adopted by the respondent in responding to the RTI application. It was felt that the conduct of respondent was against the spirit of the RTI Act, 2005 which was enacted to ensure greater transparency and effective access to the information on time.
