

The above mentioned Case stands allocated to the Bench of Shri Avtar Singh Kaler, Hon'ble State Information Commissioner. Since Shri Avtar Singh Kaler, SIC is on medical leave, therefore, this case is being heard by the undersigned in view of the Office Order dated 08.02.2021.

Shri Ashok Kumar, appellant filed RTI application dated 20.07.2020 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o District Social Security Officer, Ludhiana.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.

Both the parties are present today through CISCO Webex.

The appellant stated that he is seeking information regarding his disability pensionary benefits (P.L.A.), but the same has not been provided to him by the PIO.

The PIO stated that the appellant has filed RTI application for seeking information regarding his disability pensionary benefits (P.L.A.) as he was not getting the same since December, 2016. She further stated that the appellant has not followed the departmental procedure when his pension was sanctioned and due to that his pension benefits could not be initiated at that time, but now from April 2020 onwards his pensionary benefits has been started. The PIO further stated that the detailed reason regarding the non-payment of pensionary benefits for the period December, 2016 to March, 2020 has already been explained verbally and in writing to the appellant.

As the pensionary benefits of the appellant has been started from April 2020 and the PIO has also explained the reasons for non-payment of pensionary benefits for the period December, 2016 to March, 2020 to the appellant, so there is no further action is needed in this case. Hence the present appeal case is disposed of and closed.
