**ORDER:**

The appellant through an RTI application dated 29.05.2021 has sought information regarding copies of the map of land bearing khewat no.390,391,392,393,397 & 446 situated in village Lakha Singh Wala –a copy of the girdawari for the year 2019-20 & 2020-21 – a copy of the map of land bearing murabba No.35 & 36 as enumerated in the RTI application concerning the office of Tehsildar Ferozepur. The appellant was not provided with the information after which the appellant filed the first appeal before the first appellate authority on 05.07.2021 which took no decision on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Ferozepur. As per the appellant, the PIO has not supplied the information.

The respondent is absent nor is represented. There is nothing on record which shows that the RTI application has been attended to by the PIO. The PIO is directed to provide information to the appellant within 15 days of the receipt of the order and explain the reasons for not attending to the RTI application within the time prescribed under the RTI Act.

**Appeal Case No. 140 of 2021**

**ORDER:**

The appellant through RTI application dated 02.07.2020 has sought information regarding comparative statements approved for the purchase of medicine from 01.04.2019 to 28.02.2020 – list of all types of amounts received from the public in the hospital (daily)– amount utilized for medicine purchase and other information as enumerated in the RTI application concerning the office of SMO Batala. The appellant was not provided with the information after which the appellant filed the first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 15.09.2020 which took no decision on the appeal.

The case first came up for hearing on 11.05.2021 through video conferencing at DAC Ludhiana/ Gurdaspur. The appellant claimed that the PIO has not provided the information.

The respondent was absent. The Commission received a letter from the PIO-SMO Batala stating that the information has been sent to the appellant vide letter dated 22.06.2020. In the same letter, the PIO also claimed that no letter / RTI application dated 02.07.2020 was received by them.

The Commission observed that the reference of the letter (dated 22.06.2020) vide which the PIO claimed to have sent the information, pre-dates the RTI application (RTI application filed on 02.07.2020). This RTI application was on the file.

The PIO was directed to relook at the RTI application (a copy of which was enclosed with the order) and send a point-wise reply along with complete information to the Commission, which will be further sent to the appellant.

On the date of the last hearing on **18.08.2021**, both the parties were absent. The case was adjourned.

On the date of the last hearing on **09.02.2022**, the appellant informed that the PIO has not supplied the information.

Due to a technical fault in the VC, the respondent could not be heard. The case was adjourned.

**Hearing dated 17.05.2022:**

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Ludhiana/ Gurdaspur. As per the respondent, the information has been sent to the appellant via speed post.

As per the appellant, he has not received the information.

The PIO is directed to resend the information with an intimation to the Commission.

The case is adjourned. To come up for further hearing on **28.09.2022 at 11.00 AM** through video conference facility available in the office of Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana. The PIO is to appear through VC at DAC Gurdaspur.

The appellant was not provided with the information after which the appellant filed the first appeal before the first appellate authority on 08.08.2021 which took no decision on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Gurdaspur. As per the appellant, the PIO has not supplied the information.

The respondent is absent nor is represented.

There has been an enormous delay of more than ten months in attending to the RTI application. The Commission has taken a serious view of this and hereby directs the PIO to provide information to the appellant within 15 days of the receipt of the order and appear personally on the next date of hearing alongwith explanation for not attending to the RTI application within the time prescribed under the RTI Act.

**ORDER:**

As per the appellant, the information is incomplete and not as per the RTI application.

Having gone through the RTI application and hearing both the parties, the following is concluded:

- Point-1,2&3 - As per the respondent, the information is not specific. The PIO to relook at the application and provide information as discussed during the hearing.
- Point-4 - PIO to provide copies of the bill relating to payments made as discussed during the hearing.
- Point-5 - As per the respondent, the information has been sent to The appellant. The appellant has not received the same. The PIO to send the information again

The case is adjourned. To come up for further hearing on **12.09.2022** at 11.00 AM through video conference facility available in the office of Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana. The PIO to appear through VC at DAC Patiala.
