The RTI application was transferred U/s 6(3) of the RTI Act, 2005 to the PIO-cum-Panchayat Secretary, Gram Panchayat, Navi Abadi, Akalgarh, Block Sudhar, Tehsil Raikot, Distt. Ludhiana vide letter dated 23.09.2020.

The appellant is present today, whereas none has appeared on behalf of the PIO. The appellant stated that the PIO has not complied with the Order of the Commission.

I have gone through the previous Orders and the PIO was directed to refund the excess amount of assessed fee to the appellant by way of demand draft and to file a duly attested affidavit by submitting that due to calculation mistake he has written to the appellant to deposit Rs.1980/- as assessed fee, but the requisite information consists of only 689 pages and the information which was available in the office of the PIO has already been provided to the appellant and except that no other information is available with the office of the PIO.

But the PIO is again absent today and neither he has sent any compliance to the previous Orders. The conduct of the PIO is not fair and condemnable. So, a Show Cause Notice is issued to the PIO-cum-Panchayat Secretary, Gram Panchayat, Navi Abadi, Akalgarh, Block Sudhar, Tehsil Raikot, Distt. Ludhiana that why he has not complied with the Order of the Commission and so why he may not be penalized up to Rs.25,000/-.

The PIO is directed to file reply to the Show Cause Notice in writing and send the same to the Commission within 15 days and an opportunity of personal hearing will be afforded to him on the Show Cause Notice. In case he would not file reply to the Show Cause Notice

then it will be assumed that he do not want to say anything in his defence and the Show Cause Notice will be decided on the next date of hearing on basis of papers available on the file.

The PIO-cum-Panchayat Secretary, Gram Panchayat, Navi Abadi, Akalgarh, Block Sudhar, Tehsil Raikot, Distt. Ludhiana is again directed to refund the excess amount of assessed fee to the appellant by way of demand draft within 15 days and compliance be sent to the Commission.

The PIO should also file a duly attested affidavit by submitting that due to calculation mistake he has written to the appellant to deposit Rs.1980/- as assessed fee, but the requisite information consists of only 689 pages and the information which was available in the office of the PIO has already been provided to the appellant and except that no other information is available with the office of the PIO. The PIO should send the duly attested affidavit to the appellant and a copy of the same be sent to the Commission as compliance within 15 days.

When no information was provided to him by the SPIO, then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 08.01.2021. Then he filed Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 08.03.2021. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. The notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today through **CISCO Webex Meetings Software**.

The appellant is present today, whereas none has come present on behalf of the SPIO.

The appellant stated that the sought for information has not been provided to him by the SPIO, whereas he has filed RTI application on 25.11.2020.

So, the SPIO, O/o Sub Divisional Magistrate, Tarn Taran is directed to send the attested copies of sought for information to the appellant through registered post within 10 days and copy be sent to the Commission as compliance. In case of non compliance of the order of the Commission a show cause notice U/s 20(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 will be issued to the SPIO on the next date of hearing.
