O R D E R

Shri Harbans Lal, complainant/applicant filed RTI application dated 13.02.2020 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o Asstt. Registrar, Co-op. Societies, Malout.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.

Both the parties are absent today.

The SPIO though is absent today, but he has sent an e-mail to the Commission, which is a copy of letter no.872 dated 11.06.2021 along with a photocopy of postal receipt dated 11.06.2021, copy of letter no.871 dated 11.06.2021 and copy of Order dated 06.08.2019.

I have gone through letter no.872 dated 11.06.2021 and it is submitted by the SPIO that information sought by the complainant/applicant through point nos.1 to 4 and point nos. 6 to 8 of the RTI application are related with the Shamkot Multipurpose Co-operative Society, Shamkot and the information regarding point no.5 of the RTI application is related with the office of the SPIO, which has been sent to the complainant/applicant vide letter no.871 dated 11.06.2021 through registered post.

The SPIO-cum-Asstt. Registrar, Co-op. Societies, Malout has sent reply to the Show Cause Notice. I have gone through the reply sent by the SPIO. I am of the view that the SPIO is not personally liable for the delay in providing the information to the complainant/applicant. The SPIO has tendered unconditional apology and assured the Commission that in future the information will be provided to the information seekers within the stipulated time. So, the Show Cause Notice issued to the SPIO-cum-Asstt. Registrar, Co-op. Societies, Malout is hereby dropped and filed with a direction to the SPIO that in future he should remain more vigilant towards his duties and provide the information to the information seekers within the stipulated period.

As the SPIO has sent the information to the applicant, which was available in his office and resolved the matter involved in the RTI application, so the present complaint case is **disposed of and closed.**

O R D E R

Shri Lovepreet Singh, complainant/applicant filed RTI application dated 23.01.2021 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o Police Commissioner, Ludhiana. When no information was provided to him by the SPIO, then he filed complaint against the SPIO before the Punjab State Information Commission on 09.03.2021. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench, The notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today through **CISCO Webex Meetings Software**.

The complainant/applicant is absent today, whereas the respondent is present on behalf of the SPIO and he stated that the information sought by the complainant/applicant cannot be provided to him at this stage as the investigation is still pending.

The Commission has received an e-mail sent by the SPIO, which is a copy of letter no.523-D dated 10.06.2021 along with a copy of letter no.138 dated 08.06.2021.

I have gone through letter no.523-D dated 10.06.2021 and it is submitted by the SPIO that the complainant/applicant has sought information regarding UID No.1791464, which has been registered at Police Station, Women Cell, Ludhiana. It is further submitted that according to letter no.138 dated 08.06.2021 of Police Station, Women Cell, Ludhiana, it is reported that against UID No.1791464 case no.09 dated 22.01.2021 has been registered, which is under investigation, so the documentary information cannot be provided to the complainant/applicant at this stage, but the copy of the case has been sent to the appellant on 10.06.2021 by registered post.

As the case is still under investigation, so the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed** with the observation that whenever the investigation will be completed, the attested copies of sought for information be sent to the appellant within 15 days and compliance report be sent to the Commission .

O R D E R

Shri Gaurav Banger, complainant/applicant filed RTI application dated 08.03.2021 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o SSP, Jalandhar (Rural). When no information was provided to him by the SPIO, then he filed complaint against the SPIO before the Punjab State Information Commission on 15.03.2021. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench, The notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today through **CISCO Webex Meetings Software**.

The complainant-applicant is absent today, whereas the respondent is present and he stated that through point no. 1 of the RTI application the complainant-applicant sought information regarding application no.1133/2016, but according to the report obtained from the Incharge, RTI Branch, Jalandhar (Rural), the application no.1133/2016 was not correct and in this context letter no. 434-D dated 24.12.2020 was written to the applicant to give correct application number, but the applicant has not responded to the said letter.

The respondent further stated that regarding point no. 2 and 3 of the RTI application letter dated 11.05.2021 was written to the complainant-applicant to specify the interest in getting the said information as he has sought information regarding application no. 2-PB/89/2016 filed by Shri Manjit Singh, S/o Shri Mahinder Singh and regarding cancellation and inquiry report of FIR No. 4 dated 06.01.2018, P.S. Lambra, Jalandhar (Rural), but the applicant has not responded to the said letter also.

As the SPIO has written letter no. 434-D dated 24.12.2020 and letter dated 11.05.2021 to the complainant-applicant to specify regarding the information, but the applicant has not responded to the said letters and neither he has attended the hearing before the Commission for today, which means he is not interested in getting the information. So, the present complaint case is **disposed of and closed**.

ORDER

Shri Tejinder Singh, Advocate, appellant filed RTI application dated 21.11.2020 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o Director, Rural Development and Panchayat Department, PB. Mohali. When no information was provided to him by the SPIO, then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 28.12.2020. Then he filed Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 05.03.2021. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench, The notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today through **CISCO Webex Meetings Software**.

The appellant is present today, whereas none has come present on behalf of the SPIO. The appellant stated that the sought for information has not been given to him by the SPIO.

The Commission has received a mail sent by the DDPO, Ludhiana on 15.06.2021, diarized vide no. 12926, which is a copy of letter no. 5698-99 dated 31.05.2021 along with copy of letter no. 732 dated 29.01.2021 and copy of letter no. 550 dated 21.01.2021.

I have gone through letter no. 5698-99 dated 31.05.2021 and it is submitted by the DDPO, Ludhiana that the appellant sought information regarding status of his complaint dated 22.10.2020, but the said complaint is related with Sherpur Kalan, near Appolo Hospital, Ludhiana, so the complaint has been sent to the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana vide letter no. 550 dated 21.01.2021 and the copy of the said letter has been sent to the appellant vide letter no. 732 dated 29.01.2021.

In the light of the above mentioned facts, the appellant is advised to file a fresh RTI application before the concerned public authority. With this observation the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed**.
