1. This order may be read with the reference of previous order dated 28.05.2019.
2. Sh. Jasbir Singh, the appellant states that requisite information is still pending and nor did the respondent has given him the compensation awarded.
3. Respondent PIO is absent for today's hearing without any intimation to the Commission. He/she was also absent on previous hearing dated 28.05.2019 before the bench of undersigned and also on hearings dated 17.10.2018, 18.12.2018 & 05.02.2019 before the bench of LD. SIC Prof. Viney Kapoor Mehra.
4. After hearing the appellant and examining, it is found that a Show Cause Notice was issued to the appellant vide order dated 18.12.2018 and a Bailable Warrant was also issued vide order dated 05.02.2019, and thereafter compensation of Rs 2000/- was also awarded to the appellant dated 28.05.2019, which shows irresponsible behavior of respondent PIO.
5. In the backdrop of the aforementioned factual position, initiation of action under Section 20(1) Right to Information Act, 2005, against the concerned defaulting officer called for, I am, therefore, left with no other option but to decide the imposition of penalty upon **the concerned PIO O/o Food Safety, Moga, of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand only)**. The amount of penalty i.e. Rs. 10,000/- should be deducted from the salary of **concerned PIO O/o Food Safety, Moga**, and be deposited in the Government treasury under head 0070-Other Administrative Services-60-Other Services-800-Other Receipts-86-Fees under the Right to Information Act.
6. The Civil Surgeon shall ensure that this amount of penalty is deducted from the salary of the above said concerned defaulting official(s) and deposited in the Treasury under the relevant head and issue instructions to his official(s) to present the Challan and/or relevant evidence(s) before the Commission on next date of hearing positively. **The Civil Surgeon Moga is also directed to disclose the Name and other details of concerned defaulting officer (PIO) to the Commission and also represent this case in person or through his/her representative on next date of hearing.**
