2. Appellant, Sh. Rakesh Kumar Gupta states that requisite information is still pending from the respondent PIO. He added that I have filed RTI application in the Office of SSP instead of Thana Dhakha.
3. Respondent, ASI Jagdish Singh states that reply has already been sent to the appellant through which appellant was asked specific darkhast number but till date not provided by the appellant.
4. On this, appellant, Sh. Rakesh Kumar Gupta is not agreeing to supply any detail (regarding darkhast number etc.) to the office of Thana Dhakha and not cooperating to resolve this so that requisite information could be supplied to him.
