

He is directed to supply the information to the appellant clarifying the legal position with regard to the rules/instructions as sought by the appellant and bring along the entire relevant record and produce the same before the Bench on the next hearing.
- 6. With the aforesaid directions, the matter is adjourned. To come up for hearing on 08.11.2021at 11.30 AM before the Bench in Commission's office at Chandigarh. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
