## <u>ORDER</u>

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 04.07.2022.

2. The appellant states that the information has not been provided to him so far. He has also filed his submissions through e-mail. Copy of the same is taken on record.

3. The Respondent states that he has brought the information in pen drive today.

4. After hearing the appellant and gone through the case file, it is observed that the appellant has received incomplete information so far. The appellant Sh. Ramandeep Singh has filed RTI with the department on 30.03.2021, after lapse of more than fifteen months incomplete information has been given to him so far.

5. It is, thus apparent from the response of the PIO that there has been delay in providing the information. Appellant had also suffered financial loss in getting the information. There are systemic deficiencies in the manner of receiving and disposing of applications. The department still does not appear to be properly tuned to the performance of its obligations enshrined under the RTI Act. The departmental officials are not properly sensitized and trained to discharge their functions under the RTI Act 2005.

6. I am, therefore, of the view that the Appellant deserves to be awarded compensation under Section 19(8)(b) of RTI Act 2005 for the loss and detriment suffered by him on account of delayed supply of information.

7. I am of the view that ends of justice would be met by awarding a sum of Rs. **5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only)** by way of compensation to the Appellant. This amount shall be payable by State Exchequer within fifteen days.

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 27.07.2022 vide which the Respondent-PIO O/o DPI (colleges) Punjab was directed to bring the copy of dispatch register, showing that the RTI request of the appellant was transferred U/s 6(3) to the Principal, Ramgarhia College, Phagwara and Dr. Surinderjit Kaur had denied receiving the same.

2. Today Smt Shalini, Supdt is appearing on behalf of Respondent no.1 and has filed their reply through affidavit along with the copies of dispatch register through which the RTI of the Appellant was transferred to Principal, Ramgarhia College of Education, Phagwara. I have gone through the affidavit and have agreed with it. Copy of the same is taken on record.

3. Further, Dr Surinderjit Kaur, Principal is appearing on behalf of Ramgarhia College of Education, Phagwara. She has also brought her reply through affidavit. I have gone through the same and do not agree with it. Hence, the same is not accepted and returned to the Principal, Ramgarhia College of Education.

4. After hearing both the parties and perusing the case file, it is ascertained that the Respondent O/o DPI (colleges) Punjab have filed their reply today along with the copy of dispatch register. Hence, Principal, Ramgarhia College of Education is impleaded as Respondent no.2.

Further, it is ascertained that Principal, Ramgarhia College of Education has filed her reply through affidavit which is not correct. Hence, the same is again returned today. She had also filed an incorrect affidavit on the previous date of hearing also, which was also handed back to her.

5. The Commission observed that there is complete negligence and laxity in the public authority in dealing with the RTI application. It is abundantly clear that such matters are being ignored and set aside without application of mind which reflects disrespect towards that RTI act 2005 itself. The Commission expressed its displeasure on the casual and callous approach adopted by the Respondent no. 2 in responding to the RTI application. It was felt that conduct of Respondent no. 2 was against the spirit of the RTI Act 2005, which was enacted to ensure greater transparency and effective access to the information. Such kind of behavior of a Government servant needs to be condemned and such employees need to be taught a good lesson so that rest of the employees have a right kind of message to wake up and perform their duties under the RTI Act for ensuring complete transparency and due accountability in the governance affairs of the public authorities.

6. The information has not been provided to the Appellant till date. This has resulted in much avoidable inconvenience and hardship to the Appellant. She is, therefore, entitled to be compensated under Section 19(8)(b) of RTI Act 2005 for the loss and detriment suffered by her. In the circumstances, I am of the view that ends of justice would be met if a sum of **Rs.5000/-**(**Rupees Five Thousands Only**) is awarded to the Appellant as compensation. I order accordingly.

7. This amount shall be payable by the Respondent no. 2 i.e PIO O/o Ramgarhia College of Education, Phagwara, from the State exchequer within fifteen days from the receipt of this order under intimation to the Commission.

8. Looking at the lackadaisical and highly irresponsible attitude of the respondents, Dr. Surinderjit Kaur, Principal, Ramgarhia College is directed to show cause under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act, before the penalty is imposed as to:-

- (i) Why supply of information as per RTI request sent to her has been delayed.
- (ii) Why penalty be not imposed upon him for not supplying the information within time as prescribed under RTI Act 2005.

9. Respondent-PIO is directed to file an affidavit in this regard before the next date of hearing. Respondent-PIO is also directed to supply complete information to the appellant before the next date of hearing.

10. She may also make use of the next date of hearing for his personal hearing as well under the principles of natural justice.
