2. The representative of the respondents states that the complete information has been supplied to the complainant and he is having the receipt of the information so provided to him. He further states that the complainant is satisfied from the information and requests for the closure of the case.

3. After hearing the statement of the representative of the respondents, it appears that the complete information has been provided to the complainant. Moreover the appellant is absent without any intimation. Accordingly, the case is disposed of and closed.
