The respondent stated that the information related with point nos.2 and 5 of the RTI application is 15 to 20 years old, which is not available in the official record, so the SPIO is unable to provide the same to the appellant.

The SPIO has provided the information to the appellant which was available in the official record and regarding point nos.2 and 5 of the RTI application, the SPIO submitted that the information is 15 to 20 years old, which is not available in the official record, so the SPIO is unable to provide the same to the appellant.

Hence the SPIO has provided the information to the appellant as per the official record, so the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed**.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its Order rendered on 12.12.2011 in Civil Appeal Nos. 10787 – 10788 of 2011 (arising out of SLP © No.32768-32769/2010) has held that while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information.

So, I disposed of the present complaint case with the direction to the First Appellate Authority i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana that he should call the complainant-applicant within 30 days and personally hear him and resolve the matter involved in the RTI application by passing a speaking order and compliance report be sent back to the Commission. With this observation the present complaint case is **disposed of and closed**.
