1. The RTI application is dated **18.2.19** vide which the appellant has sought information **regarding preferred vehicle registration numbers from 1.1.2012 to 18.2.19**, as enumerated in his RTI application. First Appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **26.3.19**, and Second Appeal was filed in the Commission on **30.7.19** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005. The case was last heard on **26.10.2021**.

2. The appellant is absent without intimation. At the last hearing on 26.10.2021, the appellant was advised to inspect the record which was available on the website of the State Transport Department but only accessible via the respondent's computer. The appellant was to inspect the said record at the office of Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Sangrur, on 8.11.2021 and intimate the Commission after doing so.

3. However, as informed by the respondent vide Letter No. 3048 Dated 16.12.2021, the appellant neither went for the scheduled inspection nor did he make any attempt to contact the PIO or this Commission. It is also notable that the appellant has been absent for the six successive Hearings of this Appeal Case.

4. In view of the above the Commission is compelled to conclude that the appellant no longer wishes to pursue this Appeal Case. There is no further cause for action and this Appeal Case is herewith **CLOSED**.

1. The RTI application is dated **24.7.20** vide which the appellant has sought **information regarding the chargesheeting and suspension of ATPs, Building Inspectors and Draftsmen, including departmental inquiries initiated in all Zones etc.**, as enumerated in his RTI application. First Appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **5.10.20**, and Second Appeal was filed in the Commission on **22.2.2021** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005. The case was last heard on **15.7.2021**.

2. The appellant is absent without intimation. At the last hearing on 15.7.2021, the respondent PIO have submitted a detailed reply wherein, he also claimed that information requested in this RTI application was voluminous. The Commission had directed to respondent PIO to provide an estimate of the volume/number of pages/copies as well as the man hours required to collect all the information requested in this RTI application. In a letter to this Commission No. 16/APIO/HQ/RTI/D Dated 1.11.2021, the respondent has stated that the information pertaining to just point no. 3 of the RTI application would involve 1731 pages. The other information sought in this RTI application, in view of this Commission qualifies for exemption under Section 8 of the RTI Act 2005.

3. In view of the above, the Commission concurs with the reply given by the respondent PIO vide Letter No. 424/MTP/RTI/D Dated 25.6.2021. There is no further cause for action and this Appeal Case is herewith **CLOSED**.
