Medical records treatment, choice of medicine, list of hospitals and doctors visited, findings recorded including that of the family members, information related to assets, liability, income tax returns, details of investments, lending and borrowing, etc. are personal information. Such personal information is entitled to protection from unwarranted invasion of privacy and conditional access is available when stipulation of larger public interest is satisfied. This list is indicative and not exhaustive."
