- 1. The RTI application is dated 28.01.2021 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 15.06.2021 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 28.09.2021 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. The notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 18.01.2022 in Commission's office at Chandigarh. As such, the case has been heard today. Shri Ishwar Singh, appellant comes present to attend the hearing through cisco webex. He states that no information has been supplied to him despite a reminder being sent in this regard.
- 3. Neither the PIO O/o DDPO, Patiala has come present to attend the hearing in person nor through cisco webex nor he has deputed any of this representatives to attend the hearing. The RTI application of the appellant is dated 28.10.2021 and First Appeal is dated 15.06.2021. The Bench observes that the PIO-cum-DDPO, Patiala has written to APIO-cum-BDPO, Patran to supply information vide letter dated 03.11.2021. However, in spite of a lapse of more than one year, the appellant has not been provided information. This indifferent and lackadaisical attitude of the PIO is viewed adversely.

4. The PIO O/o DDPO, Patiala is issued show cause notice to explain his absence and as to why action should not be taken against him and also as to why penalty should not be imposed in the instant case for failing to appear for the hearing and for not supplying information to the appellant. He is also directed to file a written reply to the show cause notice as to why the appellant should not be compensated for the mental harassment suffered by him in getting the information.

- 5. In addition to the written reply, the PIO is hereby given an opportunity u/s 20(1) proviso thereto for personal hearing before the imposition of such a penalty, on the next date of hearing. He may take note that in case they does not file the written reply and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date fixed, it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceedings against him ex-parte.
- 6. The Bench directs the PIO to supply information to the appellant on the points as raised in his RTI application, before the next hearing.
- 7. With the aforesaid directions, the matter is adjourned. **To come up for hearing on 30.03.2022 at 11.30 AM through Cisco Webex.** Copy of the order be sent to the parties.
