The respondent PIO has also not intimated about the fact whether the requisite information has been supplied to the appellant or not.

The appellant has not sent any intimation whether he received the requisite information or not.

Nevertheless, last opportunity is given to both the parties to represent this case in person or through their representative on the next date fixed to intimate the status of the instant appeal-case or the case would be decided on merits.

The case is <u>adjourned to 27th October, 2022 (Wednesday) at 11:00 A. M. for hearing</u>
