ORDER:

The appellant through an RTI application dated 04.02.2021 has sought information regarding the merit list of pharmacy officer (cat-SC(R&O) – Panel list/list of candidates joined for the post of pharmacy officer according to the number of posts (48) – posts vacant as enumerated in the RTI application concerning the office of Director Health and Family Welfare, Pb Chandigarh. The appellant was not satisfied with the reply of the PIO dated 12.03.2021 after which the appellant filed the first appeal before the first appellate authority which took no decision on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Ropar. As per the appellant, the PIO has not provided the information.

The respondent present pleaded that since the recruitment process was not complete, the information was not provided and the reply was sent to the appellant vide letter dated 12.03.2021.

The Commission has received a copy of a letter dated 10.03.2022 from the PIO on 16.03.2022 vide which it has been informed that the information cannot be provided as per notification of the Department of Governance Reforms and Public Grievances dated 09.08.2021.

Having gone through the RTI application, the Commission observes that the appellant has sought information regarding the merit list of the candidates who applied for a job in the Govt department, which is neither 3rd party nor the personal information of any persons, hence it cannot be denied. The appellant is not asking for marks sheets of the candidates but a merit list which is created for seeking a government job and there is a clear distinction between a mark sheet and an evaluation report/merit list. A mark sheet unless used for obtaining a job remains a personal document, whereas the merit list is a list of candidates who have scored more than the cut off marks and have been selected for the next stage after an interview or the job. Moreover, It is a common practice to display merit lists on notice boards.

From the facts above, it is clear that the PIO has wrongfully interpreted the circular. Hence the PIO is directed to provide information on all points within 15 days of the receipt of the order and send a compliance report to the Commission.

With the above orders, no further interference of the commission is required. The case is **disposed of.**
