Heard through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'.

The RTI request is dated 03.12.2020. First appeal is dated 12.01.2021. Second appeal has been received in the Commission on 05.03.2021.

On the last date of hearing, held on 01.06.2021,

- i) The respondent PIO concerned was directed to supply the certified copies of the required information to the appellant through registered post with a copy to the Commission.
- ii) An opportunity was given to the appellant to confirm whether he has received the information and also advised to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO so that the same could be removed by the respondent concerned.

The appellant, Sh. S. S. Sharma, who appeared in person in today's hearing, states that no information has been supplied to him by the respondent PIO so far.

Sh. Mannveer Singh Sidhu, Senior Assistant-cum-APIO, who appeared on behalf of the respondent PIO in today's hearing, states that information could not supplied to the appellant as information demanded through RTI request is regarding appointment and category of Sh. Sanjay Kanwar, Superintending Engineer(Civil) with a copy of his Medical Certificate as Handicapped candidate, which is 'personal information' and through Para 59 of Decision dated 13.11.2019, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has defined 'Personal Information' under RTI Act, 2005 in a Civil Appeal no. 10044 of 2010 titled Central Public Information Officer, Supreme Court of India Vs. Subash Chander Agarwal and relevant part of the 'para 59' has been forwarded by Under Secretary to Government of Haryana, Department of Administrative Reforms vide letter dated 05.01.2021, which has been forwarded to the Commission vide letter no. 505 dated 20.05.2021. It has been received in the Commission vide Diary no. 11264 dated 25.05.2021, which is taken on record.

During the hearing when the appellant was asked that what public interest is involved in the disclosure of information, which has been sought by him through R*TI request*, he could not come with satisfactory answer.

As through Para 59 of Decision dated 13.11.2019, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in Civil Appeal no. 10044 of 2010 titled Central Public Information Officer, Supreme Court of India Vs. Subash Chander Agarwal, has defined 'Personal Information' under RTI Act, 2005 and the relevant operative part of the Judgment is reproduced below;

XXX XXX XXX

"Reading of the aforesaid judicial precedents, in our opinion, would indicate that personal records, including name, address, physical, mental and psychological status, marks obtained, grades and answer sheets, are all treated as Personal Information. Similarly, professional records, including qualification, performance, evaluation reports, ACRs, disciplinary proceedings etc. are all Personal Information'. Medical records, treatment, choice of medicine, list of hospitals and doctors visited, findings recorded, including that of the family members, information relating to assets, liabilities, income tax returns, detail of investments, lending and borrowing, etc. are Personal Information'. Such 'Personal Information' is entitled to protection from unwarranted invasion of privacy and conditional access is available when stipulation invasion 'Larger Public Interest' is satisfied. This list is indicative and not exhaustive."

After hearing both the parties and examining the documents placed in the case-file, it is found that information sought for by the appellant through his RTI request is 'personal information' in nature and he has also failed to disclose that what public interest involved in the instant appeal-case. Moreover, under clause (j) of Section 8 (1) of the RTI Act 'personal information' can not be given to the information-seeker where the information-seeker failed to establish the fact that information sought for by him is in larger public interest, hence, the above-mentioned appeal is not maintainable and dismissed.

In view of all the above, the instant appeal-case is announced as <u>closed</u>. Copies of the orders be sent to the parties.


