On not receiving information from the PIO or on filing First Appeal with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 17.08.2020, the Appellant filed Second Appeal in the Commission on 14.10.2020 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act) and as such Notice of hearing was issued to the parties.

The case is fixed for today. The Appellant states that no information has been provided to him. The Respondent states information sought by the appellant could not be provided to him, as the same relates to the subject of security and the Security Wing of Punjab Police has been kept out of the purview of the Right to Information Act, 2005 vide notification dated 23.02.2016 and dated 07.06.2016 and same has been conveyed to the appellant vide letter dated 09.09.2020 whereas the appellant shows his dissatisfaction.

In the light of the above, appellant sought information relating to details of security cover provided to various protectees, which cannot be provided to him in the interest of security of protected persons. No further action is required in this Appeal Case, hence, the case is **disposed of and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the parties.
