

- 3. Smt. Sarabjit Kaur, Senior Assistant, Freedom Fighters Welfare Department, Punjab comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench. She states that the information has been supplied to the appellant on Point No.1 of his RTI application on 10.06.2022 and then on 24.06.2022 whereas no information relating to point No.2, 3 & 4 is available in the official records.
- 4. Shri Chattar Singh, appellant is contacted on mobile phone. He is made to talk to the representative of PIO Smt. Sarabjit Kaur who explains to him the details of information supplied and the position regarding non-availability of information in the official records on Point No.2,3 & 4. Then the Bench talks to the appellant and apprises him of the version of representative of PIO. The appellant is convinced with the position explained by the representative of PIO.

ORDER:

- 1. The RTI application is dated 02.06.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 04.07.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 25.08.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. The notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 18.10.2022. Accordingly, the case has been heard today. Shri Narinder Singh, appellant comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench and states that no information has been received by him yet.
- 3. Shri Devinder Singh, AEE, PSPCL Rural, Sirhind comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench and states that the information was supplied to the appellant vide letter dated 03.08.2022 and also hands over a copy of the same to the appellant in the court itself.
- 4. The Bench advises the appellant and the respondent to sit in the adjacent court room. The appellant further is advised to peruse the information supplied and to see if he finds the information in order or there is any deficiency and then to report back to the Bench.
- 5. Thereafter, the appellant and the respondent appear before the Bench and the appellant states that he is not fully satisfied with the reply given by the PIO. The Bench, however, apprises him that the Bench is convinced with the reply of the PIO. Then, he concurs with the opinion of the Bench and expresses satisfaction with the documents given.
- 6. In view of the above, the Bench does not feel need for further intervention in the matter. **The instant appeal case is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.

ORDER

- 1. The RTI application is dated 25.06.2021 vide which the Complainant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. Complaint was filed in the Commission on 24.08.2022 under Section 18 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. The notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 11.10.2022. The case has been heard today. Shri Tejinder Mohan Mahendru, complainant comes present in person before the Bench and states that he has sought information regarding electricity power cable passing by his house which is a big danger to their personal life, but no information has been supplied.
- 3. Neither the PIO O/o Dy. Chief Engineer, Operation, West Circle, PSPCL, Ludhiana has come present in person before the Bench or through cisco webex.
- The Bench observes that the complainant has his grievance regarding an electricity power cable passing by his house about which he has sought information. He has, however, directly approached the Commission by preferring complaint in the Commission. The Bench further observes that the complainant has not availed the provision of Section 19(1) of the RTI Act by filing an appeal with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). As such, the FAA has not been able to address the grievances of the complainant. The attention of the Complainant is drawn to the decision of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India rendered on 12.12.2011 in Information Commissioner and another Versus State of Manipur and another in para 31 whereof, it has been held that while entertaining a complaint case under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005,

the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information which is as under:-

31. We uphold the said contention and do not find any error in the impugned judgment of the Hon'ble High Court whereby it has been held that the Commissioner while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the said Act has no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for access to the information."

As such, since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provisions of Section 18 of the RTI, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission.

- 5. Since there is an alternative and efficacious remedy of First Appeal available to the Complainant under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 which has not been availed in the instant complaint case and the First Appellate Authority has not had the occasion to review the decision of PIO, as envisaged under the RTI Act by passing a detailed well reasoned speaking order.
- 6. The instant matter is remanded back to the **First Appellate Authority i.e. Shri Parvinder Singh Khamba, Chief Engineer, Central Zone, PSPCL, Ludhiana.** The Commission hereby directs the FAA to treat the copy of the Complaint (enclosed herewith) as the First Appeal and decide the matter in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act after giving all concerned parties an opportunity to be heard. He is directed to hear the complainant within ten days and decide the matter.
- 7. In case, the complainant is not satisfied with the decision of the First Appellate Authority (FAA), he is at liberty to file second appeal before Punjab State Information Commission Section 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005.
- 8. In view of the above, **the case is disposed off and closed.** Copy of the order be sent to the parties.


- This order may be read with reference to the order dated 14.09.2022 passed by this Bench on 1. the previous hearing.


- 1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 14.09.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
