#### ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 03.11.2020 vide which a show cause notice was issued to the respondent-PIO.

2. The appellant Sh. Gagnish Singh states that no information has been given to him so far.

3. Smt. Ashima Aggarwal is appearing on behalf of the respondent.

4. After hearing both the parties, it is observed that no information has been given to the appellant. The perusal of the file shows that the respondent has not attended any hearing in the Commission. He has even not bothered to send any reply to the Commission office, which shows that the respondent has no regard for the orders issued by the Commission. This is indeed a serious matter.

5. The RTI Act is meant for promoting transparency in governmental functioning by bringing to light governmental actions done behind closed doors so that the common man is kept well informed of the goings on in the public authorities with a view to strengthening democracy. The RTI Act 2005 is not to be used as a substitute for availing of services available under various statutes for matters not involving the bringing to light the mannerism of / flaws in the working of public authority.

6. In view of the defying attitude of the respondent-PIO (Sh. Devinder Pal Singh, GM (Personnel)-cum-PIO neither attending the court nor submitting any explanation for the delay in supplying the information within the time schedule as prescribed under the RTI Act 2005, the court comes to a logical conclusion that it is a fit case for the imposition of penalty amounting to Rs. 25000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand only) on the PIO. But, taking a lenient view, I impose a penalty of **Rs. 10000/- (Rs. Ten thousand only) on** Sh. Devinder Pal Singh, GM (Personnel)-cum-PIO.

7. The Managing Director, o/o PSIEC is directed to deduct the amount of penalty of Rs. 100000/- from the salary of Sh. Devinder Pal Singh, GM (Personnel)-cum-PIO and deposited in the State Treasury in the following Head of Account and to report its compliance to the Commission:-

#### <u>ORDERS</u>

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 03.11.2020.

2. Today, the Appellant states that the information has not been provided to him so far.

3. The Respondent states that the information demanded by the Appellant is very voluminous. Hence, the information could not be provided. Further, the Respondent has also filed their reply in this regard. Copy of the same is taken on record.

4. The perusal of the file shows that that the information has not been provided to the Appellant so far. However, the Respondents has filed their reply mentioning therein that the information demanded by the Appellant is very voluminous. The appellant may take note that there is a judgment of The Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No. 6454 of 2011 Central Board of Secondary Education **Vs** Aditya Bandopadhyay and ors. has in its judgment dated 09.08.2011 observed as under -

(37 Indiscriminate and impractical demands or directions under RTI Act for disclosure of all and sundry information (unrelated to transparency and accountability in the functioning of public authorities and eradication of corruption) would be counter-productive as it will adversely affect the efficiency of the administration and result in the executive getting bogged down with the non-productive work of collecting and furnishing information. The Act should not be allowed to be misused or abused, to become a tool to obstruct the national development and integration, or to destroy the peace,

tranquility and harmony among its citizens. Nor should it be converted into a tool of oppression or intimidation of honest officials striving to do their duty. The nation does not want a scenario where 75% of the staff of public authorities spends 75% of their time in collecting and furnishing information to applicants instead of discharging their regular duties. The threat of penalties under the RTI Act and the pressure of the authorities under the RTI Act should not lead to employees of a public authorities prioritising 'information furnishing', at the cost of their normal and regular duties.)

5. However, on the request of the Appellant, an opportunity is given to the Appellant to state his case.
