A penalty of Rs. 25,000/- was imposed upon Shri Harpreet Singh, VDO, O/o BDPO, Pakhowal. Shri Harpreet Singh stated that the amount of penalty of Rs. 25,000/- had been deducted from his salary for the month of January, 2019, but he has not presented any compliance report.

So, the case is adjourned to **02.04.2019** for awaiting the compliance report.

Ludhiana vide Order dated 25.07.2018. The Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Pakhowal, Distt. Ludhiana was directed to deduct the amount of penalty of Rs.10,000/- from the salary of Shri Jagtar Singh, Panchayat Officer.

On the last date of hearing, the Commission had received a mail sent by the PIO-cum-BDPO, Pakhowal, Smt. Rupinder jit Kaur, stating that the amount of penalty has been deducted from the salary of Shri Jagtar Singh, but she has not sent the copy of challan, so the BDPO, Pakhowal was directed that the receipt of challan for deposit of amount of penalty of Rs.10,000/- be sent to the Commission and come present on the next date of hearing.

But today none has come present on behalf of BDPO, Pakhowal and neither he sent copy of challan.
