This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 10.2.2021.

2. The appellant has sought the following information:-

"....the following information is being sought under the Right to Information Act 2005 regarding the Public Servants falling under Group A & B (Class I & II) of the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana. This information is required for the year 2016, 2017, 2018 & 2019.

- 1. Provide certified copy of the information (for the above said years) showing the Total Number of the Public Servants that failed to file their annual Property Returns with their concerned Public Authority and failed to show compliance with the aforesaid Statutory Rule.
- Provide Certified Copy of the Information (for the above said Years) showing the Names and Designations of the officers that failed to file their Annual Property Returns with their concerned Public Authority and failed to show compliance with the aforesaid Statutory Rule.
- 3. Provide Certified Copy of the Information showing the Action taken by the Competent Authority against those Public Servants who failed to file their Annual Property Returns with their concerned Public Authority and failed to show compliance with the Statutory Rule as asked under Point No. 2 of this Application.
- 4. If till date, no action has been taken against the Officers who have failed to file their Annual Property Returns with their concerned Public Authority, then Provide the Reasons for the same as available on the records of your Public Authority.

 Provide Certified Copy of the Information showing the Action and the Punishment that can be initiated as per the Law of the Land against an Officer who fails to file his Annual Property Return in compliance of the aferesaid Statutory Rule.

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3. The representative of the respondents states that the appellant has sought the information regarding the property returns of the IAS, PCS, Tehsildar and Naib Tehsildars i.e. Point No. 1 & 2 of the RTI application, which is being filed on HRMS and the information pertaining to the previous years. He further states that the controlling officers of these public servants/officers are Chief Secretary, Financial Commissioner and Divisional Commissioner respectively. Regarding Point No. 3, the representative of the respondents states that nothing is available on record in the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana. Regarding Point No. 4 the representative of the respondents states that the sought information does not cover under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005 i.e. "if till date, no action has been taken against the officers who have failed to file their Annual Property Returns with their concerned Public authority..". Regarding Point No. 5 of the RTI application, the information has already been supplied i.e. instruction bearing No. 559 dated 17.5.2012. He has also placed on record a letter bearing No. 1052 dated 12.3.2021 written to the appellant with a copy to the Commission in this regard. However, the representative of the appellant states that in case the respondent authority does not have the information then the RTI application of the appellant should have been transferred to the concerned public authority under Section 6(3) of the RTI Act, 2005.

4. It is appropriate to mention the instructions issued by the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances Pensions, Department of Personnel & Training vide No. 10/2/2008-IR dated 12th June, 2008 and the relevant portion of the para is reproduced below:-

"3(iii)...It may be noted that the Act required the supply of such information only which already exists and is held by the public authority or held under the control of the public authority. It is beyond the scope of the Act for a public authority to Create information. Collection of Information, parts of which arre available with different public authorities, would amount to creation of information which a public authority under the Act is not required to do. At the same time, since the information is not related to any one particular public authority, it is not the case where application should be transferred under sub-section (3) of the Section 6 of the Act. It is pertinent to note that sub-section (3) refer to 'another public authority' and not 'other public authorities'. Use of singular form in the Act in this regard is important to note."

4. After hearing both the parties, going through the instruction issued by the Government of India mentioned herein and submissions made by the parties, the Commission accepts the plea taken by the respondents. Therefore, the Commission observes that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed.

Regarding The respondents have also tenders the unconditional apologies for the delay of information and assured that the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005 will be adhered to.
