She further explains the facts before the Court and also requests to waive off the penalty amount of Rs. 10,000/- from their concerned PIO, <u>which is unacceptable.</u>

In view of above, the concerned PIO is directed to supply the requisite information to the Appellant and deposit the penalty amount Rs. 10,000/- to the Government Treasury (**as mentioned in previous order of the Commission dated 18.01.2022**) and inform the same to the Commission through email or registered post within a month failing which an action would be taken against the concerned PIO, on the next date of hearing which is going to be heard through Cisco Webex Meetings Software.

# The PIO is also directed to submit the copy of the postal receipts to the Commission vide which information would have been supplied to the Appellant, by the next date of hearing.

Also, the Appellant, Sh. Jatinder Kumar is directed to go through the supplied information, once he

receives the same from the Respondent/PIO and point out deficiencies in written, if any, to the Respondent/PIO through registered post or through email, with a copy to the Commission, failing which it would be presumed that he has nothing to say and the case would be decided on merits.
