ORDER

- The RTI application is dated 30.12.2021 vide which the appellant has sought information as 1 enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 14.02.2021 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 03.12.2021 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- The notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 19.04.2022 through cisco webex. As such, 2. the case has been heard today. Shri Hakam Singh, appellant comes present to attend the hearing through cisco webex.
- Shri Jaskaran Singh, Superintendent, O/o BDPO Sri Muktsar Sahib comes present to attend 3. the hearing through cisco webex. He states that the information has been supplied to the appellant vide letter dated 31.03.2022 and then vide letter dated 04.04.2022, as the record of Gram Panchayats is off-line. Certain information relates to MGNREGA which is available on the website and the requisite link was also provided to the appellant. He further states that certain detail of bank accounts of PIDB grants has been asked for from the concerned banks and the same would be provided to the appellant on receipt of the same. He also states that RTI application has also been transferred under Section 6(3) of RTI Act to different PIOs/ Panchayat Secretaries/ VDOs of a number of Gram Panchayats in Block Gidderbaha vide letter dated 06.01.2021.

4. On enquiring from the appellant, he states that he has sought information from 01.01.2014 to 30.12.2020, but he has not been supplied information for three years and the information is incomplete. He is apprised that information available on the website is not to be provided and the appellant must access the same from the website.

- 5. Post deliberations and perusal of the RTI application as well as the correspondence made by the PIO O/o BDPO Gidderbaha, the Bench observes that letters dated 06.01.2021, 02.03.2021 and 21.03.2021 have been sent by PIO O/o BDPO Gidderbaha to all the PIOs-cum-Panchayat Secretaries/VDOs in Block Gidderbaha asking them to supply related information to the appellant directly. The perusal of letter dated 06.01.2021 shows that the information sought by the appellant relates to 16 (Sixteen) PIOs i.e. VDOs and Panchayat Secretaries and each of them performs his duties in respect of more than one Gram Panchayats in Block Gidderbaha. The Bench also observes from the version of the appellant and the representative of PIO that the information sought by the appellant relates to different issues and it entails collection, collating and compilation of information and thus, a number of PIOs are involved in the same.
- 6. The Bench, as per observations made above, is of the view that the appellant cannot seek information on single RTI application from multiple public authorities. A Full Bench of State Information Commission, Punjab has in Complaint Case No.2903 of 2011 decided on 13.01.2012, ruled as under:-

"We hold that under Section (3) of the Act ibid, the legal obligation of a PIO who receives a request for information under Section 6(1) of the Act is limited to transfer this request to only one public authority that hold the information. This obligation does not extend to transfer the request to multiple authorities.

- The Bench further observes that the PIO O/o BDPO, Gidderbaha, Districat Sri Muktsar Sahib has made efforts to supply information to the appellant by forwarding RTI application to different PIOs/VDOs of Gram Panchayats in Block Gidderbaha vide letter dated 06.01.2021 but the information asked for by the appellant has to be collected, collated and compiled, thereby resulting in wastage of time of multiple PIOs involved. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in matter of CBSE vs. Aditya Bandopadhyay, (2011) 8 SCC 497, held as under:-
 - "67. Indiscriminate and impractical demands or directions under the RTI Act for disclosure of all and sundry information (unrelated to transparency and accountability in the functioning of public authorities and eradication of corruption) would be counterproductive as it will adversely affect the efficiency of the administration and result in the executive getting bogged down with the non-productive work of collecting and furnishing information. The Act should not be allowed to be misused or abused, to become a tool to obstruct the national development and integration, or to destroy the

peace, tranquility and harmony among its citizens. Nor should it be converted into a tool of oppression or intimidation of honest officials striving to do their duty. The nation does not want a scenario where 75% of the staff of public authorities spends 75% of their time in collecting and furnishing information to applicants instead of discharging their regular duties. The threat of penalties under the RTI Act and the pressure of the authorities under the RTI Act should not lead to employees of a public authorities prioritizing "information furnishing", at the cost of their normal and regular duties.

8. In view of the above, it does not seem to be appropriate for the appellant to seek information which may entail engaging 75% of the employees of a public authority to collect and compile the information for furnishing the same to the appellant. The Bench advises the appellant to go for seeking information by filing separate RTI application before a specific public authority who has its separate PIO.
