The appellant, Sh. Rajinder Singh also through a letter dated 17.07.2021, which has been received in the Commission through an e-mail, has intimated the Commission that he has not received the required information in the instant appeal-case. It is taken on record.

Sh. Parminder Singh, S. D. O., who appeared on behalf of the respondent PIO in today's hearing, states that earlier office of P.W.D. (B & R), Provincial Division, Moga was under Superintending Engineer, P.W.D. (B & R), Construction Circle, Ludhiana now it comes under Superintending Engineer, P.W.D. (B & R), Construction Circle, Faridkot and seeks an adjournment in this case so the at the required information could be supplied to the appellant.

Nevertheless, another opportunity is given to the respondent PIO to send the certified copies of the requisite information to the appellant through registered post with a copy to the Commission within three weeks from today.

A copy of this order also be sent to Superintending Engineer, P.W.D. (B & R), Construction Circle, Faridkot for intimation.

Another opportunity is also given to the appellant to confirm whether he has received the information (which would be sent by the concerned PIO) or not. He is also advised to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO or it would be assumed that he is not willing to pursue this case further and the case would be decided on merits..
