After going through the RTI request, it emerges that the information sought for by the appellant through the RTI request, is not 'third party' information and the concerned respondent PIO is directed to supply the certified copies of the required information to the appellant, as per queries raised by him through his RTI request through registered post before the next date of hearing and send a copy of the postal receipt, (through which information would be sent to the appellant) on the next date of hearing.

An opportunity is given to the appellant to confirm whether he has received the required information or not. He is also advised to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO well in time so that the same could be removed by the respondent concerned by the next date of hearing.

The case is <u>adjourned to 21<sup>st</sup> October, 2020 (Wednesday) at 11:00 A. M. for</u> <u>hearing through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'.</u> Copies of the orders be sent to the parties.
