3. It is appropriate to mention that Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order rendered on 12.12.2011 in Civil Appeal Nos.10787 – 10788 of 2011 (arising out of SLP @ No.32768-32769/2010) has held that while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information. Since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provisions of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission.

An alternative and efficacious remedy of first appeal is available to the complainant under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 which has not been availed in the instant case. Since the complainant is interested in getting the information, therefore, the matter is remanded back to Sh. Amarjit Singh Bhatia, First Appellate Authority-cum- District Education Officer(Elem), Gurdaspur to take appropriate decision in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act within the prescribed timeline, after giving opportunity of hearing to all

RTI Act, 2005 and then file the first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 28.7.2021. Thereafter, the appellant filed the 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal before the Commission and the Commission treated the same under the general category as the sought information, mentioned herein, does not cover under Life and Liberty clause.

5. The appellant filed the RTI application to the Public Information Officer on 14.7.2021 and filed the first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 28.7.2021. From the above, it is evident that the respondent-Public Information Officer did not get the mandated period of 30 days to respond to the RTI application, as per the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

6. It is also a fact on record that the penalty has been imposed upon the Public Information Officer without mentioning his name and designation.

7. Keeping in view the submissions made by the parties, record available in the case file and after consideration, the penalty amounting to Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousands only) is hereby withdrawn.

8. Accordingly, the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed.

4. The representative of the respondents submits that the appellant has sought the copy of enquiry report which is yet to be received from Tehsildar Ludhiana (East), Ludhiana. He has also sent a copy of the reminder issued to Tehsildar, Ludhiana (East), in this regard, which is taken on record and also a copy of the same is **being sent** to the appellant along with this order.

5. Keeping in view the submissions made by the respondent, the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed.

## ORDER

The RTI application is dated 26.4.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter called FAA) on 30.5.2022 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 28.7.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter called RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for today.

2. The appellant has sought the following information as per his RTI application:-

3. The appellant is absent but he has sent the written submissions in this case, which are taken on record.

4. The respondent-Public Information Officer submits that the appellant was approached twice through District Deputy Director, Animal Husbandry-cum-Cow Welfare Officer, Moga by sending a staff at the mentioned address but the appellant neither came out of his house nor cooperated to share his mobile number. Also the appellant has not mentioned his mobile number while filing the 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal in the Commission.

5. Due to non-cooperation with the respondent and absence of the appellant, the Commission accepted the submissions made by the respondent and is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed. However, the Commission observes that the respondent may consider putting the information sought on their website, being of public interest.
