I have gone through the Order dated 03.03.2021 and the SPIO, O/o BDPO, Bhunerheri, Distt. Patiala was directed to send the attested copies of complete information to the appellant through registered post within 10 days with a copy to the Commission.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.

The complainant-applicant is present today, but none has appeared on behalf of the SPIO. The complainant-applicant stated that no information has been provided to her by the SPIO.

The Commission has received an e-mail sent by the SPIO, which is a copy of letter no. 17514-15 dated 26.04.2021 along with copies of information.

I have gone through the above said letter vide which the sought for information has been sent to the complainant/applicant and a copy of the same has also been sent to the Commission.

I have gone through the RTI application dated 18.03.2020 filed by the complainant/applicant and she sought information regarding case number 0067 dated 28.03.2019. I have also gone through letter no.17514-15 dated 26.04.2021 and it is submitted by the SPIO that the inquiry regarding the complaints filed by the complainant/applicant was conducted by the SP(Investigation), Amritsar (Rural) and it is further submitted by the SPIO that the copy of inquiry report is being sent to the complainant/applicant vide this letter.

But as the complainant/applicant stated that no information has been provided to her by the SPIO, so the SPIO is directed that the attested copies of sought for information be again sent to the complainant/applicant through registered post within 3 days and compliance report be sent to the Commission.
