ORDER

Shri Mehar Chand, appellant filed RTI application dated 19.01.2021 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Nathana, Distt. Bathinda. When no information was provided to the appellant by the SPIO, then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 26.02.2021. A reply was sent to him by the SPIO vide letter no.26 dated 12.03.2021. But not satisfied with the reply of the SPIO, the appellant filed Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission on 05.04.2021. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today through **CISCO Webex Meetings Software**.

Shri Madan Lal, authorized representative is present on behalf of the appellant, Shri Mehar Chand, whereas none has appeared on behalf of the SPIO.

The representative of the appellant stated that the information related with point nos. 1, 2 and 3 of the RTI application has been provided to the appellant by the SPIO, but regarding point no.4 of the RTI application, it is replied by the SPIO that this information is not related with the office of the SPIO i.e. BDPO, Nathana rather it relates with the office of the PWD (B&R) department.

I have gone through the RTI application dated 19.01.2021 and also gone through the reply dated 12.03.2021 sent by the SPIO.

The SPIO has provided the information related with point nos. 1, 2 and 3 of the RTI application to the appellant and regarding point no.4 of the RTI application, it is replied by the SPIO that this information is not related with the office of the SPIO i.e. BDPO, Nathana rather it relates with the office of the PWD (B&R) department. So, the appellant is advised that in case he wants to get the information related with point no. 4 of the RTI application, then he should file RTI application before the concerned public authority. With this observation the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed**.
