ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 17.9.2019. The case was earlier heard by the bench of Sh. Sanjiv Garg, SIC but due to administrative reasons the case was reallocated to this bench.

2. The relevant portion of the order passed by the bench of Sh. Sanjiv Garg is reproduced below:-

“In today’s hearing, the Appellant, Sh. Dinesh Kumar states that no information has been supplied to him till date.

The APIO, Sh. Hardiyal Singh pointed out that, the Appellant’s RTI Application is not only addressed to O/o STC, Punjab, Chandigarh, apart from that it is also addressed to O/o RTA, Ludhiana as well as to O/o SDM East, Ludhiana.

After discussing with both the parties and examining the documents placed on record, I am of the considered view that this case to be remanded to First Appellate Authority, O/o Deputy State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, SCO-177-178, Sector 17-C, Chandigarh, with the directions to decide the case as per

provisions of the RTI Act, after giving due opportunity to the parties concerned, examining the evidences, documents placed on record/submitted by the parties concerned and subsequently pass an order. A copy of this order along with RTI request be sent to the First Appellate Authority i.e. Deputy State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, SCO-177-178, Sector 17-C, Chandigarh through registered post.

If the Appellant is not satisfied with the decision of the First Appellate authority, he is free to approach the Commission within one month.

Copies of the orders be sent to the parties through registered post.”

3. Keeping in view the above, the liberty was granted to the appellant to approach the Commission within one month but since then no submissions have been received from the appellant. Therefore, the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed.
