The appellant also submits that the filing of the 2nd appeal cases should have been online for the convenience of the general public for which the facility has already been made available to the general public through the portal of the Commission i.e. www.infocommpunjab.com

4. According to the specific reply/information supplied to the appellant, the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed.
