After hearing the submissions made by the respondent, the show cause notice issued to Sh. Dharminder Singh, EO and Sh. Iqbalpreet Singh Randhawa, MTP is hereby withdrawn.

4. Keeping in view the above, the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed.
