The appellant, Sh. Yogesh Mahajan is absent from today's hearing without any intimation to the Commission.



The RTI request is dated 08.08.2020. First appeal is dated 01.10.2020. Second appeal has been received in the Commission on 08.12.2020.

On the last date of hearing, held on 24.03.2021, Ms. Asha Rani, Block Primary Education Officer, Mangat –II, who appeared with Sh. Varinder Kumar, Lecturer, Govt. Sr. Sec. School (Multi-purpose) Ludhiana, stated that the information sought by the appellant through his RTI request could not be supplied to him as it is 'third party' information.
