



Jagshir Singh states that the requisite fees (i.e. Rs. 600/-) has not been deposited by the Appellant within time that is why the information has not been supplied to him and further requests the Court to go though the letter number 301 dated 17.06.2022 which has been sent to the Commission for clarifying the facts of this case and is taken on record.

On further discussing about the fees part if the Appellant, Sh. Pankaj Bansal has received such letter number 547 dated 08.12.2021 to which the Appellant, Sh. Pankaj Bansal denies the same and moreover no proof of the same has been presented by the APIO today or sent to the Commission along with the letter dated 17.06.2022 which shows that the requisite fees has been requested by the concerned PIO from the Appellant. Also, during discussion it has also been found that the penalty amount Rs. 10,000/- which was imposed on to the concerned PIO vide orders dated 28.02.2022 has also not been deposited to Government Treasury by the department till date.

Commission takes a serious view of the casual approach of the Respondent / PIO and the concerned PIO is directed to supply the information to the Appellant, Sh. Pankaj Bansal " free of cost " through registered post and for non compliance of orders dated 28.02.2022, the penalty amount of Rs. 10,000/- (which was imposed on 28.2.2022) has been enhanced by Rs. 5,000/- (i.e. enhanced today) = Total Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) is imposed upon the concerned PIO O/o Executive Officer, Nagar Council, Dhanaula.

A copy of this order be sent to him through registered post.

The amount of penalty will be deposited in the treasury of Punjab Government under the head.....
