- 5. I am, therefore, of the view that ends of justice would be met by awarding a sum of Rs. 2500/- (Rupees Twenty Five hundred only) by way of compensation to the Appellant. This amount shall be payable from the State Exchequer before the next date of hearing.
- 6. In this case, it is derived that the respondent-PIO is intentionally delaying the supply of information and he has no respect for the orders of the Commission to be present, either himself or through his representative in the court.
- 7. In view of the defying attitude of the respondent-PIO neither attending the court nor submitting any explanation for the delay in supplying the information within the time schedule as prescribed under the RTI Act 2005, the court comes to a logical conclusion that it is a fit case for the imposition of penalty amounting to Rs. 25000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand only) on the PIO. Therefore, taking a lenient view, I impose a penalty of Rs. 2500/- (Rs. Twenty Five hundred only). The Drawing and Disbursing Officer of the office of DDPO, Ludhiana is directed to deduct the amount of penalty of Rs. 2500/- from the salary of PIO, o/o BDPO, Ludhiana-1, Ludhiana and deposited in the State Treasury in the following Head of Account and to report its compliance to the Commission:-


